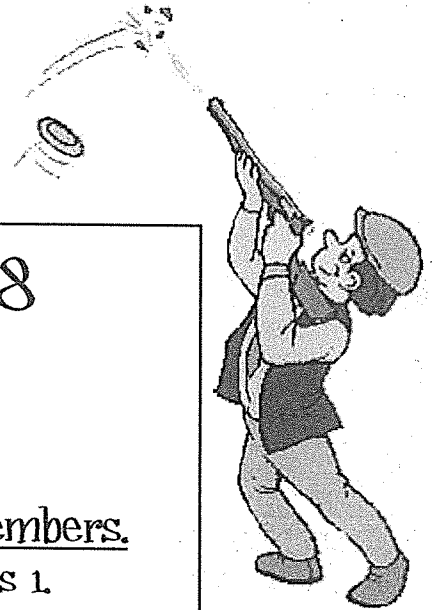


What is a Trap Shoot? Trapshooting is a shotgun sport, in which 5 participants (squad) shoot together at small disks that are launched in the air called, clay pigeons. There are five stations, laid out in an arc. A round of trap is 25 clay pigeons, 5 being shot from each station in rotation. - *May bring own 20 Gauge Shotgun, but not shells

SCOREKEEPER

- *This is not a serious competition, but a scorekeeper will be provided for each squad.

*Scoring is based on the final scores as they are posted when the shoot has been completed and gives every contestant an equal chance to win, no matter what his/her shooting ability.

*When all the shooting has been completed, the scores are listed in numerical order from the highest to the lowest. They are then divided into groups according to score. The highest score in each class is the winner!
